Trivia

Though the Louisiana Purchase comprised all or part of 15 present United States, it did not encompass all of today's State of Louisiana. Two important areas of our state were not acquired by the Louisiana Purchase. The Florida Parishes which revolted against Spain in 1810 were annexed to the United States by order of President James Madison. They were added to those parishes obtained by the Purchase to create the 18th state of the Union in 1812. Had this not happened, Baton Rouge would not be our state capital today. More significantly, the 2007 BCS Champions could have been the University of West Florida rather than Louisiana State University.

The buffer territory between New Spain (Mexico) and the western border of Louisiana was not fixed in its present configuration until the Adams-Onis Treaty of 1819, seven years after statehood was granted to Louisiana. That treaty also settled disputes with Spain concerning Florida and fixed that state's present boundaries.

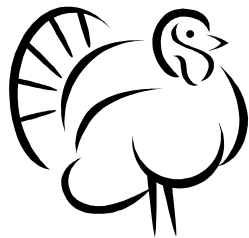
